

ASA Descriptions

Band: Sarah Burvill

This club is for everyone who would like to sing or play an instrument together in a band. We will use guitars, drums, keyboards and microphones to perform covers of current, popular songs.

Japanese Club: Motoko Uda

This club will focus on basic Japanese language skills, as well as cultural activities such as sushi making. Students will practise both spoken language and some reading and writing.

Science Club: Tom Wade & Sarah Burvill

A science club, which will be based around the use of fun, exciting and educational science experiments appropriate for all the age groups in ASA.

Photography Club: Craig Jones

The MYP ASA Photographic club is a club in which students will learn basic through to advanced practical camera techniques and how to process and print their images from a digital format. This club requires students to bring

their own cameras to give the students maximum time taking pictures and practising.

Payment Structure

There is a new MYP ASA fee this year, which will be 500DKK per month. Students who sign up for activities every day will pay the full 500DKK fee but students who only wish to participate in one or two activities will be charged per activity. So one activity a week would cost 100DKK a month, two activities would be 200DKK and so on up to 5 activities.
